Terms and Conditions:

- Candidates have been selected as per the Institute norms. No communication / recommendation, etc. in this regard will further be entertained. The candidates who are not selected in this programme might be given opportunity in the future workshops / training programmes, etc. subject to availability of programme and approval of the competent authorities.
- The selected candidates must bring a valid ID card confirming their designation / affiliation as mentioned in the application form. Without a valid ID card, their admission to the workshop will be cancelled. Participants must bring a copy of their ID card as well as the original registration form for the purpose of submission.
- The candidates are required to bring their own bed sheet, blanket, mosquito coil, toiletries, etc.
- Candidates selected for the above programme are requested to bring the text books on / of language and literature / Hindi grammar which are used in the classroom for the purpose of teaching / learning of Hindi.
- The participants will be paid nominal TA (3rd AC for Govt. Lecturer/Assistant Professors/ Teachers/ Research Scholars/Guest Lecturer/Contractual Faculty members, etc.,) as per the

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institute rules. All tickets (Bus /Train) must be booked through IRCTC or official govt. counters/website/mobile application of respective state transport department. Tickets booked via Pvt. Website/portals/vendors will not be accepted. Similarly, journey performed via private/personal transport/ vehicles will not be reimbursable at any cost. No request/communication will be entertained in this regard.

- Participants must also bring two set of copies of their journey tickets along with original tickets for the purpose of submission.
- Any due amount of TA to the participants will preferably be credited to their bank account within 30 working days from the last day of the programme. Hence, participants must bring a copy of their own bank passbook consisting relevant details (A/c No, IFSC, etc.). Full attendance and active participation in the programme is essential to become eligible for compensation of any kind.
- A simple vegetarian Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner will be provided during the programme. No preferences, requests, choices, change in the menu, etc. will be entertained. Accordingly, moderate free accommodation is arranged in **SRLC- Guest House (Southern Regional Language Centre, CIIL, Mysuru)** for the selected participants as per availability. No request will be accepted regarding change in accommodation. Candidates may wish to choose to live outside on their own. No reimbursement will be made in such cases at any cost. No arrangement for accommodation will be made for accompanying spouse / family members / friends, etc. at any cost.
