INTRODUCTION

About Item File Card (IFC)

Item File Card (IFC) is meant for writing question items. This card is made in a specific size (A4) and have 10 columns to enter various technical values like **1)Administering Details, 2)Instruction to the examinee, 3) Question/ Item stem (with answer key/cue) 4) Scoring Procedure 5)Subject matter/input (Sub-component) 6) Objective (Instructional, Education, Societal) 7) Item Type/Format used 8) Medium & mode of presentation 9) Educational level and 10) Rationale.** These are known as **10 Parameters** of a question item.

About Application

This web application is to help the user to input the question items through online portal. Inputted question items automatically get stored into MILES database.

System Requirements

- Desktop/Laptop with minimum specification (Core 2 deo processor with 2 GB RAM OS windows XP, 7 & above etc.)
- Unicode enabled Desktop/Laptop with browsers like Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Internet Explorer, etc. The use of latest version of such browsers is highly recommended.

- **Our web based question item inputting application supports only Unicode. We recommend you to use "Gautami" font. Make sure that this font is available in your Operating System.**

Step 1: Open any browser

Step 2: Enter this link in the Address Bar of the browser www.ciil-ntsindia.net/Telugu




Step 3: Enter Username.

3. Enter Options if any
4. Enter Answer Key
5. Enter Marks (only digits)
6. Enter Time in Minutes (only digits)
7. Select Scoring Procedure
8. The sub component that you have selected will already be displayed
9. Enter the Question writer's intention
10. Click on Next Button

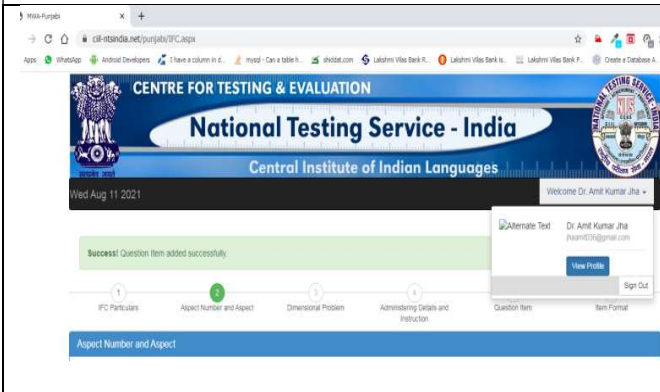

Step 12: Enter the details in the following screen

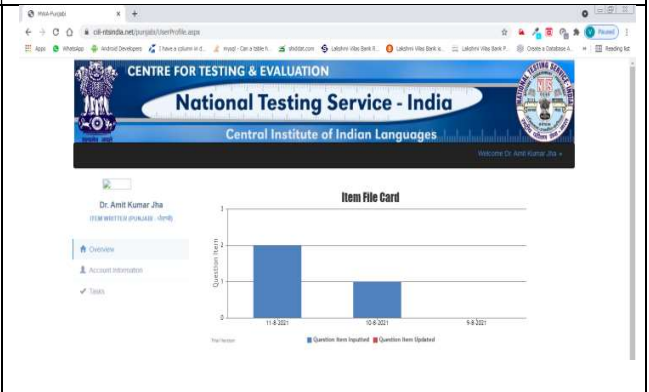
1. Select Mode of presentation (Select Written in this case)
2. Select Educational level
3. Enter Rationale
4. Choice Index will be displayed by the system itself.
5. Feasibility value will be displayed by the system itself.
6. Discrimination value will be displayed by the system itself.
7. Mean Ability Index will be displayed by the system itself.
8. Level of Pre-Validation will be displayed by the system itself.
9. Click on Submit Button.
