INTRODUCTION

About Item File Card (IFC)

Item File Card (IFC) is meant for writing question items. This card is made in a specific size (A4) and have 10 columns to enter various technical values like **1)**Administering Details, **2)**Instruction to the examinee, **3)** Question/ Item stem (with answer key/cue) **4)** Scoring Procedure **5)**Subject matter/input (Sub-component) **6)** Objective (Instructional, Education, Societal) **7)** Item Type/Format used **8)** Medium & mode of presentation **9)** Educational level and **10)** Rationale. These are known as **10 Parameters** of a question item.

About Application

This web application is to help the user to input the question items through online portal. Inputted question items automatically get stored into MILES database.

System Requirements

- Desktop/Laptop with minimum specification (Core 2 deo processor with 2 GB RAM OS windows XP, 7 & above etc.)
- Unicode enabled Desktop/Laptop with browsers like Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Internet Explorer, etc. The use of latest version of such browsers is highly recommended.

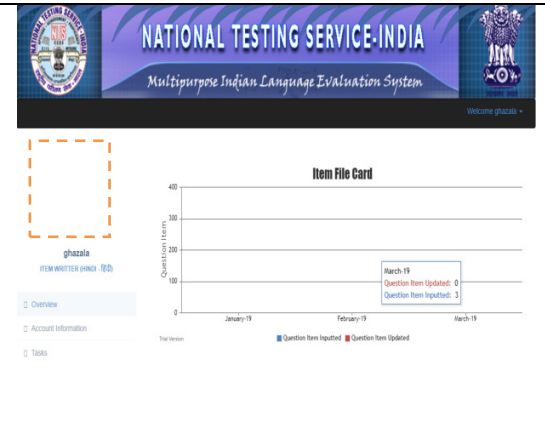
1. Select Mode of presentation (Select Written in this case)
