<p>Summary of the Educational Visit:</p> <p>A group of 32 students accompanied by two Assistant Professors of English from the Department of English, REVA University, Bengaluru, visited the Central Institute of Indian Languages on 28 April 2026 at 10:30 AM. The event was organised at Committee Room No. 2 as part of an academic engagement initiative aimed at providing students with exposure to institutional research activities and career pathways in language studies.</p> <p>The session commenced with a formal welcome by Dr. Murali Mohan N., Local Coordinator of the event, who extended greetings to the visiting students and faculty, as well as to the officials and resource persons from CIIL.</p> <p>In his address, Dr. Pankaj Dwivedi, Assistant Director, CIIL, provided a comprehensive overview of the Institute's mandate, key initiatives, and ongoing schemes, highlighting its pivotal role in the development and promotion of Indian languages.</p> <p>This was followed by thematic presentations by resource persons representing various CIIL schemes and projects, including Dr. Biresh Kumar (Senior Resource Person, NTS-I), Dr. Prattipati Matthew (Chief Resource Person, NTM), Dr. Shubanan Mandel (Senior Resource Person, BVP), and Dr. M. The resource persons outlined the objectives and activities of their respective schemes, highlighting contributions to language pedagogy, testing and evaluation, translation, data collection, language preservation, and the development of language repositories, Language technology & NLP in brief.
