<p>कार्यक्रम का सारांश</p> <p>Summary of the programme (English).</p> <p>The National Testing Service–India (NTS-I), a flagship scheme of the Central Institute of Indian Languages (CIIL), Mysuru, organised a One-Day Orientation Programme on “Basics of Testing and Evaluation in English in light of NEP 2020” for the Teachers & Lecturers of Oom Shreenikethana Trust, Srirangapatna, Mandya on 14th May 2026 at the Preview Theatre of CIIL, Manasagangotri, Mysuru.</p> <p>The inaugural session commenced with the rendition of the Naada Geethe (State Anthem), followed by formally inaugurated by watering a plant. Dr. Biresh Kumat SRP–Academic, NTS-I, delivered the Welcome Address, extending a warm welcome to the dignitaries, faculty members, and student participants.</p> <p>Later, Dr. Pankaj Dwivedi, outlined the objectives of the orientation programme and highlighted the academic relevance of strengthening assessment literacy among teachers, particularly in the context of the pedagogical reforms envisaged under the NEP 2020.</p> <p>The Inaugural Address was delivered by the Prof. Ramu, Academic Director, ONST who underscored the significance of adopting systematic and scientific approaches to evaluation in teacher education. He highlighted that effective assessment practices play a pivotal role in enhancing the quality of teaching-learning processes and contribute significantly to achieving the broader educational objectives outlined in NEP2020.</p> <p>The Felicitation Address was delivered by Dr. L. R. Prem Kumar, Officer-in-Charge, Classical Languages, CIIL, who spoke about the academic and research initiatives undertaken by CIIL in the domain of language education.</p> <p>Prof. P.R. Dharmesh Fernandez, Professor-cum-Deputy Director, CIIL delivered the presidential address, highlighting the importance of strengthening multilingual academic resources and</p>	

collaborative efforts in the field of testing and evaluation.

The inaugural session concluded with a Vote of Thanks proposed by Dr. Murali Mohana N., Officer (General), NTS-I, CIIL who expressed his sincere gratitude to the dignitaries, resource persons, participants, and organising team for their valuable contributions towards the successful conduct of the programme.

The academic sessions featured expert lectures by NTS-I faculty members. Dr. R. Shakunthala spoke on the “Basic Concepts of Testing and Evaluation,” explaining key aspects of educational assessment, test construction, reliability, and validity. Dr. Biresh Kumar delivered a session on the “Significance of Teachers and Teacher Education as Envisioned in NEP 2020 and NCF 2023,” highlighting the evolving role of teachers and competency-based education. Dr. Vidyarati Joshi addressed “Communication and Language Skills for Teachers,” emphasising effective communication and language proficiency in teaching-learning processes. The sessions ends up with a practical demonstration by Shri K.S. Raghavan on the MILES website, NTS-I Question Bank, and Question Paper Retrieval System.

The programme concluded with an interactive feedback session, during which participants appreciated the informative and engaging sessions, followed by the National Anthem. The programme was locally coordinated by Dr. Murali Mohana N., Officer (General), NTS-I, under the guidance of Dr. Pankaj Dwivedi, Officer-in-Charge, NTS-I. The successful organisation of the programme was made possible through the dedicated support and coordinated efforts of the NTS-I team and CIIL staff.
