Terms and Conditions:

1. **Selection Process:** Candidates have been selected as per the Institute's norms. No further communication, recommendations, or requests will be entertained regarding this selection. Candidates who are not selected for this programme may be considered for future workshops or training programmes, subject to availability and approval by the competent authorities.

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2. **Reporting Requirements:** At the time of reporting for the training programme, each participant must carry the original ID proof (e.g., Passport, Aadhar Card, or any other ID card issued by the State or Central Government). Participants should also submit a photocopy of PAN card and front page of Bank passbook, showing the account details (Name, Account Number, and IFSC Code).
3. **Required Materials:** Candidates selected for the above programme are requested to bring Odia textbooks on language, literature, and Odia grammar that are used in the classroom for teaching and learning purposes. Participants are also encouraged to bring their own laptops.
4. **Attendance and Participation:** Full attendance and active participation in the programme is essential to become eligible for Certificate and Local conveyance. The Local conveyance will be credited to the given bank account within 30 working days from the last day of the programme.
5. **Meals and Refreshments:** Working lunch and refreshments will be provided according to the extended norms of CIIL.
6. **Accommodation:** No accommodation will be arranged by DIET, Koraput, Odisha or The Central Institute of Indian Languages (CIIL), Mysuru.
